

SHOTESHAM PARISH COUNCIL.

Defibrillator. The Parish Council is pleased to report that the defibrillator is now installed in the BT Box on The Common, and ready to use.



There is a simple picture guide on the front panel explaining how it should be used. There are four stages you need to follow

1. You will have **firstly called 999** to seek emergency help re: an ambulance/Doctor etc.
2. If appropriate they will advise where the closest defibrillator is ..The BT box at the Common... and **provide the code** to open the yellow cabinet.
3. Once the cabinet is opened, **take the defibrillator to the 'patient'**. There is a video/audio which tells you what to do
4. **Follow the instructions on the video** as you wait for the ambulance/doctor to arrive.

We are planning to hold some training sessions in late January 2015 at The Trinity, where it is hoped villagers will volunteer to become 'first responders' available for emergencies.
