Shotesham Heritage Trail gives you a chance to find out more about the history of the village from the information displayed on boards outside 38 houses and other properties. The information shown was compiled by the interested householders themselves through individual research and sometimes knowledge passed down through the generations. Inside both churches, All Saints and St Marys, you can pick up a map, and quiz sheet, which is just for fun, and follow the trail around the village. The boards

will be up until September so you can walk round anytime.
