## Message from Inspector Selvarajah

This is my last update as the Inspector responsible for local policing at Costessey, Wymondham, Hethersett & Mulbarton, Poringland and Loddon. I am moving to a new role and become the new Operational Training Manager for Norfolk Constabulary. I am handing over to Acting Inspector Dave Burke who has over 10 years' experience in policing South Norfolk so I leave you in a very capable hands. I wish Dave every success in his new role. We have had a busy month, but have achieved some significant results. We have arrested, charged and remanded a man responsible for 86 incidents of damage to motor vehicles which occurred on the A143 and A146. He awaits Crown Court sentencing. We have made two arrests for the high value arson committed in Poringland and supported our partners with policing and subsequent of caravans and campervans from Whitlingham Lane. Crime and Anti- Social Behaviour are down on last month and our social media presence has increased. Please follow us on @SouthNorfPolice and you can see what your local police are doing. It's been a pleasure to serve the communities of South Norfolk for nearly 4 years and I am extremely grateful for the support from our community and partners, thank you.

## Crime Updates

Offence	Numbers	What could this entail
Arson	0	Damage caused as a result of fire.
Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)	0	Harassment, alarm or distress is caused in a non-crime incident.
Burglary - Business and community	0	Thefts committed in shops, businesses and other property
Burglary - Residential	0	Entry to any building within the curtilage/boundary of a residence, e.g. garden sheds and garages
Criminal Damage	1	A person destroys or damages property belonging to someone else.
Domestic	0	Domestic incidents where a crime has not occurred. Parties are aged 16 or over and have been intimate partners or family members regardless of sexuality.
Hate Incident	0	Any incident where a crime has not occurred which the victim, or anyone else, thinks is based on someone's prejudice towards them because of their race, religion, sexual orientation, disability or because they are transgender.
Race or Religious aggravated public fear	0	Any crime determined to have a hate element as per above.
Possession of controlled substance	0	Unlawful possession of a drug classified in class A, B or C.
Possession of weapons	0	Unlawful possession of an article used as a weapon.
Public fear, alarm or distress	0	Public order offences e.g. from a verbal altercation to offences just short of violence.
Robbery	0	Includes a range of offences where force is used, threatened or the victim is put in fear.
Theft from a motor vehicle	0	Any item stolen that was in, on or attached to a motor vehicle.
Theft or unauthorised taking of a motor vehicle	0	Any motor vehicle including those abandoned.
Theft of pedal cycle	0	From a public place.
Theft from a person	0	Purse being taken from a handbag, or a mobile phone from a shopping basket.
